



Prof. Andrzej Górak graduated in 1973 from Department of Chemistry of Technical University of Lodz, Poland. He has got his PhD degree from Institute of Chemical Engineering of the same University. He was senior researcher at the Institute till 1988 before joined Henkel kGaA in Düsseldorf as senior researcher. In 1992 he has got his “Habilitation” degree from RWTH Aachen and was appointed for professorship at Department of Chemical Engineering of Dortmund University. In 1996 he became Chair of Fluid Separations at University Essen and four years later he has got the same Chair at University Dortmund. He is also Professor at the Technical University of Lodz, Poland.

He is editor of the scientific journal *Chemical Engineering and Processing* and chairman and/or member of national and European Working Parties on Fluid Separation, Process Simulation, and Process Intensification. His scientific interests are reactive and bioreactive separation processes, process intensification, computer aided process engineering. Additionally, the research is focused on experimental investigations of reactive and hybrid separation processes like reactive distillation and membrane separation.
